## Abundant Life

Jesus tells us that He came to give us life - abundant life (John 10:10). The Greek word used here means superior, extraordinary, surpassing, uncommon, more excellent. As we learn to submit to God, we find an abundance of His joy and peace even in the midst of difficult circumstances. God promises that He knows our physical needs and will meet them (Matthew 6:25-33), but the richest abundance is found in our spiritual relationship with God.

- God Offers Abundant Life

*John 10:10* <sup>10</sup>The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

Jesus came to give us eternal life, which is an abundant life. In John 10:10, the idea of God's abundant life is placed in contrast to what the thief offers. God gives our lives more than we could ever imagine; Satan takes away from life whatever he can.

- Through Christ's Lordship

*Philippians 2:10, 11* <sup>10</sup>that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, <sup>11</sup>and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Submitting daily to Christ demonstrates that we see Him as Lord of our lives. When we do this, He promises the blessing of abundant life. Submitting to Christ brings about obedience in our lives. Psalm 1 says those who are yielded to His Word, those who delight in it, will prosper in everything they do (verses 2, 3). This blessing applies to the abundant promises of God. We can trust Jesus to help us and to bring joy and peace regardless of our circumstances. Abundance through Christ's lordship will never run out.

*Psalm 36:7-9   <sup>7</sup>How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God!
